

# **RESURRECTION AND RESTORATION**By His wounds we are healed (Isaiah 53:5).

-Father Michael Arbanas

The joyful proclamation of the Lord's Resurrection – Christ is Risen! – is not the end of Jesus' story, but rather a new beginning for each one of us who calls on His name.

It's a joyful time, of course, and we will certainly rejoice. And there is still much to do.

The world is still broken, still in great need of healing. Our calling as the Church – the Body of Christ – and as individual members is to bear witness to the opportunity for a new life, one that is filled with the presence of God, that comes from Him who said, "Behold, I make all things new (Rev 21:5)."

Before Great Lent began, we commemorated the moving story of the Prodigal Son's being welcomed by his father back into the family that the son himself had broken by leaving and squandering his inheritance. What is this, if not healing?

And in the Midnight service of Pascha we sing, in our joy, these beautiful words of restoration: "Let us call 'Brothers' even those who hate us!"

To be healed, in the Scriptures, is to be restored to wholeness – to the state in which we were meant to be. And this healing applies to all aspects of life: physical, emotional, spiritual, relational, and societal, among them.

Ultimately, it is the image of God in us that needs healing, and this restoration is exactly what the Resurrection brings to humankind. No longer do illness, death and separation have the final word; God's love conquers everything that tries to spoil God's image in us. And trusting in this salvation – this healing – gives us the courage and the strength to bear witness to it and be a presence of God's healing in a world that desperately needs it. Christ is Risen!



A few months ago OCMC welcomed at the Mission Center Fr. Anastasios the Vicar General under Simona, Metropolitan Gregorios of Cameroon. During his visit, Fr. Anastasios shared updates on ongoing projects supported by OCMC and outlined future plans in the Metropolis.

Highlighting a significant initiative, Fr. Anastasios shared a scholarship project supported by OCMC stating that it not only provided over 200 scholarships, but also provided livestock to families, in a

particularly under-served area of northeast Cameroon home to the Toupouri ethnic group. He emphasized the positive impact, stating that this endeavor is, "helping to develop positive relationships with the government because we are the only church group to be offering such assistance in this area."

In an effort to communicate the status of our loan for the St. Nicholas Family Life Center & renovations to St. Nicholas Church, below is a condensed timeline to recap the past 20 years.

1999: Purchased 10 acres in Town & Country for \$2,500,000

2003: Retired the land loan for a total of \$3,200,000

2010: First St. Nicholas Capital Campaign raised \$4,000,000 in pledges and construction began on the St. Nicholas Family Life Center as well as the renovations at St. Nicholas at Forest Park

Total cost to complete construction of the St. Nicholas Family Life Center and major renovations to St. Nicholas Church on Forest Park of \$8,500,000

2012: Signed loan documents for \$5,855,024

2015: Refinanced to a lower 3% interest municipal bond loan of \$5,273,184

2020: Extended our current municipal bond loan for 5 years at the same 3% interest rate and continuing the same amortization schedule

2024: As of April 2 our current loan amount is \$1,001,140.64 Our monthly mortgage payment is \$25,500

We have made significant strides towards paying off our debt. Thank you for your continued love and dedication to our Parish.



### Ways to Give: Qualified Charitable Distributions

A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) allows individuals who are 70½ years old or older to donate up to \$100,000 total to one or more charities directly from a taxable IRA instead of taking their required minimum distributions.

- It's a smart way for individuals who don't/can't tax benefits from their charitable donations.
- QCDs are not included in taxable income.
- QCDs satisfy RMDs without increasing adjusted gross income, thus lowering or eliminating Social Security benefit taxation, Medicare premiums, alternative minimum tax, 3.8% investment surtax and medical expense deductions, or being bumped to a higher marginal tax bracket.
