EXPERIENCING HOLY WEEK

Thomas, called the Twin, said to his fellow disciples, "Let us also go [to Jerusalem], that we may die with Him." John 11:16



Holy Week is the most solemn, sacred time of the year, and it can be heartbreaking. Yet we enter into week knowing where it's headed - the Resurrection of the Lord and the victory of God's love over sin and death - so we enter it willingly.

The week is meant to be not only a re-enactment of Jesus' last days, but a remembrance. Re-enactment is historical and physical, but remembrance, in Scriptural terms, connects us spiritually and emotionally with the event.

But for that to happen, we must really enter into the week spiritually and emotionally, ourselves – to walk with the Lord from the joy of Palm Sunday, through the conflicts with the scribes and Pharisees, the heartbreak of Judas' betrayal and even His death on the Cross.

The services themselves help us in this effort. Again and again, we hear the word Today. Not, Once upon a time, but Today. Not then, but now.

"Today, He who suspended the earth in the waters is suspended on a cross," the priest chants as he carries the Cross through the church during the Matins of Holy Friday (served on Holy Thursday evening). Minutes later, we'll hear St. Mark's account of Jesus being nailed to the Cross, the soldiers casting lots for his garments and the passers-by mocking him.

Over and over, the services put us in the midst of the Lord's Passion. We even enter the Tomb with him on the evening of Holy Friday, when we pass under the kouvouklion as we re-enter the church after the procession.

This is an image our life in Christ – we join Him on the Cross (on which He joined us in our mortality), so that we might also join Him in the Resurrection, for this, ultimately, is where Holy Week takes us.

So let's enter into this week, as much as possible, with "all our hearts, with all our souls and with all our minds," so that we might really be transformed by His glorious Resurrection!

- March 30 We hosted our Oratorical Festival with some amazing presentations, ٠ displays of iconography and mobiles representing teachings of Jesus.




