A PRAYER FOR **OUR HEALERS**

This month, we're delighted to begin something new at St. Nicholas Church – a special prayer for our parishioners who work or volunteer in health care.

On Sunday, August 17, at the end of the Divine Liturgy, we'll invite our many physicians, nurses, therapists, aides, support staff and anyone else who works in health care to the front of the church. We'll ask the Lord to work through them to bring healing – both of body and soul - to the patients they serve. And we'll anoint their hands, asking the work of those hands will always be the work of God's love for people who are hurting.

This new prayer springs from our Healing Initiative – an ongoing effort to emphasize our parish as a place of healing. The Church, after all, is sometimes known as the "spiritual hospital," and Jesus' ministry in the Gospels is marked not only by the miraculous cures of many illnesses, but also – and more importantly – the mending of our broken relationship with God.

Given our church's location across the street from one of the region's major medical centers and the many parishioners we have working in health care throughout the region, this focus on the healing aspect of Jesus' ministry is natural. Look for more to come.

We've chosen August 17 for this prayer because it's the closest Sunday to the feast of St. Diomedes the Physician, the 3rd century martyr from Tarsus who healed many people in Christ's name and who brought many people to the faith. He is one of a number of saints who are known as "Unmercenary Healers" because they healed people without asking for payment.

We encourage all of our health-care workers to be present for this special prayer, and we look forward to further developing this emphasis on the healing work of Christ.

St. Nicholas Scholarship Program

Every year, the St. Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church Community awards up to five scholarships to qualifying high school graduates and current university/college/vocational school students.

In order to qualify for a scholarship, the applicant must be:

- An Orthodox Christian and member in good standing (current steward) of the St. Nicholas Community.
- A graduate or graduate-to-be of an accredited high school, or enrolled or about to be enrolled in a community college, college, university, or vocational school.

Awards are based upon the extent of faithful participation in and service to Orthodox Christian ministries and activities. All applicants must submit with their application form and other supplemental materials Church Activity Attendance Forms, Orthodox Outreach/Parish Service/Youth Activity Attendance Forms, and an essay or video as outlined in the application. It is strongly suggested that students planning to apply for a 2026 award begin preparing these elements now.

Copies of the forms are available on the church website, from the church office, or from the adult supervisor of each outreach activity. The new 2026 application will be available on the church website beginning in September, 2025, and informational sessions will be held after liturgy in September/October, January, and March, prior to the May, 2026 deadline.

A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) allows individuals who are 70½ years old or older to donate up to \$100,000 total to one or more charities directly from a taxable IRA instead of taking their required minimum distributions.

- QCDs are not included in taxable income.
- QCDs satisfy RMDs without increasing adjusted gross income, thus lowering or eliminating Social Security benefit taxation. Medicare premiums, alternative minimum tax, 3.8% investment surtax and medical expense deductions, or being bumped to a higher marginal tax bracket.



Embrace, Encourage, and Empower: Changing Women's Lives in the **Democratic Republic of the Congo**



A full and vibrant expression of the Orthodox Christian Faith is one that offers all people a welcoming

embrace, steadfast encouragement, and meaningful empowerment. The Church, wherever she finds herself, strives to make the physical and spiritual lives of others better through outreach, opportunity, community, and the sacraments.

For centuries, missionaries, priests, and bishops have ventured to new lands to help improve the lives of others and offer salvation in Jesus Christ. In the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC), this fundamental task of the Church is being led by five hierarchs working to make a difference in the lives of their flocks and others.

Across the country, the Church in the DRC is carrying out vital ministries. In the capital, Kinshasa, the only accredited Orthodox Theological School in Africa prepares future clergy. Children throughout the country are receiving a good education at Orthodox schools.

In the spirit of 1 Thessalonians 5:11, "...encourage one another and build one another up," His Eminence Metropolitan Chariton of Kananga is also working to help Congolese women in the DRC by creating community, providing opportunity, and offering support.

Through generous contributions from Orthodox faithful like you, a Mission Center grant of \$27,000 has enabled the Metropolis of Kananga to establish the Cutting and Sewing Training Project – a six-month intensive training program for women in the region.

The funds from this grant have been used to purchase sewing machines and supplies for 31 recent graduates of the program following months of intensive training. The program will be expanded to 50 women in its next phase.

His Eminence noted that the women have near perfect attendance (some even bring their children to class!), and in a recent report from the Metropolis, it was shared that, "The financial support of the Orthodox Christian Mission Center has truly relieved the pressing need of unemployed young people. Women heads-ofhousehold in the city of Kananga and its surroundings have seen their professional capacity increased after six months of practice."

Thanks to your ongoing prayers and support, the Church in the DRC will continue to grow and empower women in its diocese through her ministries.


