

We have an extended Spring this year. The weather got us off to an early start, with many of our flowers poking their heads out and blooming in February. Meanwhile the calendar has given us Pascha on May 5 -- almost as late as it can fall (May 8 is the latest date possible).

This means that all of April this year is a time of spiritual effort as we prepare ourselves for the Resurrection. The springtime flowers, young birds and even the sunnier days should be a foretaste for us of the sense of new life in Christ that we celebrate at Easter.

We need this encouragement because Lent is difficult work. We're called to struggle with our most deep-seated and selfish impulses through increased prayer, fasting and almsgiving, recognizing that none of this effort would bear fruit without God's mercy and help.

To help us in this difficult Lenten effort, the Church gives us another form of support – the Liturgy of Presanctified Gifts. We have this extra opportunity in the middle of the week to receive the Body and Blood of Christ, to give us strength on our journey and encouragement in our struggles.

It is called "Pre-sanctified" because the Eucharist is consecrated at the previous Divine Liturgy, rather than at this evening service. In keeping with the character of Lent, the service is more solemn than our Sunday worship, and the prayers are quite moving. It's customary to fast from all food and drink before receiving Communion – either all day, after breakfast or – at the very least – after lunch.

Our church has the wonderful custom of sharing a Lenten meal after the service, hosted each week by a different parish group. We pray that all our parishioners will take advantage of this beautiful way to deepen their Lenten experience and therefore heighten their joy in the Resurrection.





Dear St. Nicholas Parish Family,

In an effort to communicate the status of our loan for the St. Nicholas Family Life Center & renovations to St. Nicholas Church, below is a condensed timeline to recap the past 20 years.

1999: Purchased 10 acres in Town & Country for \$2,500,000

2003: Retired the land loan for a total of \$3,200,000

2010: First St. Nicholas Capital Campaign raised \$4,000,000 in pledges and construction began on the St. Nicholas Family Life Center as well as the renovations at St. Nicholas at Forest Park

Total cost to complete construction of the St. Nicholas Family Life Center and major renovations to St. Nicholas Church on Forest Park of \$8,500,000

2012: Signed loan documents for \$5,855,024

2015: Refinanced to a lower 3% interest municipal bond loan of \$5,273,184

2020: Extended our current municipal bond loan for 5 years at the same 3% interest rate and continuing the same amortization schedule

2024: As of March 5 our current loan amount is \$1,223,785.99 Our monthly mortgage payment is \$25,500

We have made significant strides towards paying off our debt. Thank you for your continued love and dedication to our Parish.



Ways to Give: Qualified Charitable Distributions

A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) allows individuals who are 70½ years old or older to donate up to \$100,000 total to one or more charities directly from a taxable IRA instead of taking their required minimum distributions.

- It's a smart way for individuals who don't/can't tax benefits from their charitable donations.
- QCDs are not included in taxable income.
- QCDs satisfy RMDs without increasing adjusted gross income, thus lowering or eliminating Social Security benefit taxation, Medicare premiums, alternative minimum tax, 3.8% investment surtax and medical expense deductions, or being bumped to a higher marginal tax bracket.
